THREE MAJOR AIRPORTS SERVE LONG ISLAND

TAKE A FERRY HERE AND TO OUR OUTLYING ISLANDS

Long Island is served by two year-round ferry lines that cross Long Island Sound and connect Bridgeport, Conn., to Port Jefferson, II, and New London, Conn. to Orient Point, II. If you want to visit Fire Island where no cars are allowed, the most convenient way is to take one of six passenger ferry routes, or take the Fire Island water taxi between beaches.

Furthermore, you can travel from the North Fork to the South Fork of Long Island through Shelter Island via two short ferry rides. All Long Island ferries are listed here — call for current schedules and rates.
